1. Minutes of the last meeting

The minutes were agreed with the following correction:

Members of the Rickeys Co-ordinating Group are Colin, Russell, Tony, Wendy, Andy and Paul.  
Members of the Liaison Group are Colin, Russell and Paul.

2. Chairman's Report

Wendy welcomed everyone to the meeting.

- The bench has been repaired by the Parish Council.
- The tree stump will be removed and Michael has purchased a 10 ft oak tree which will be planted shortly. The fly tipping on FP 12 has been cleared.
- Chris Sweeney is still sorting out the sign and chevron – on going with Highways. Six potholes have been filled.
- The whole of the crescent to Chapmore End is scheduled for resurfacing in 2012.
- Andy is to request BT to complete the fibre optics installation before the road is resurfaced.
- Norma Garton of the Parish Council may be joining us at the next CEA meeting.
- The Spring Walk is to be postponed until 30<sup>th</sup> May – meet at 11 am at the Old Dairy for 11.30 walk.

It was suggested that the Street Party should include a Dog Show (a fun show), and Wendy will ask the Woodman if we could hold it in the Woodman Garden. She will also ask the Parish Council if we could hold the Street Party on the Green outside the Leary House. Timetable for this is to be agreed at a later date. Wendy and Andy will discuss the Dog Show with Nina and it was suggested that a £3.00 fee be charged for each dog entered. We will be asking for contributions towards the tea.

A thank you Email from Tony Vickers was circulated.

3. Treasurer's Report

The balance in the business reserve account stands at £7,101.10 and in the current account £709.62, although there is £103.49 to come out, leaving a balance of £606.13.

The Christmas Party raised the sum of £120.95.

Fund Raising

The Association is still short of its £10,000 goal, and needs to undertake more fund raising activities. It was suggested that the Chapmore End Map should be promoted at £25.00 and that Joy should be approached about producing a 'Chapmore End' Christmas Card. Helen will contact Pat Corbett re the dog show. There was discussion about the Car Boot Sale, with suggestions that there should be a charge for the pitch and also for people entering. The date was confirmed as 12<sup>th</sup> September.

#### 4. Gravel (reported by Colin Kemp)

The conditions have been agreed including the 106 agreement (outside the boundary of the site). The application for new plant is expected before the end of the month. It is important that there are no objects as the new plant is more efficient and much quieter than the old plant. It is expected that the old plant will be removed within the six months after granting of planning permission.

Colin attended a walk about with Hanson in the late Autumn. Hanson agreed to a number of points including fencing, hedging etc but to-date very little action is apparent. A meeting is set to take place with Tony and Hanson in the Spring. Andy brought up the fact that Hanson do not carry out the works that they say they will do, and surely this is an indication that they will not take notice of the 50 points, as they are not even installing the security fencing. Colin will report the fact that nothing has happened.

Saturday working will be taking place with the restriction that no processing takes place. The permission is limited to exporting and maintenance, to limit noise emissions. If Hanson breach this agreement they will not be able to continue Saturday working.

After some discussion it was agreed to postpone decision on names of monitors for noise, dust, B158 and general security until a later date. Concern was expressed about the date of the new application, as we would wish to have at least one years experience of the workings and how Hanson operate, before considering the next gravel application.

Rights of Way – it has been accepted that the width should be 3 m for bridleways over Rickneys. A proposal to upgrade our part of Gypsy Lane will be put on the next Liaison Meeting agenda.

#### 5. Any other business

It was agreed that a Newsletter be sent out. Wendy and Jan to co-ordinate, giving dates of events. A reminder for the Clean Up weekend will be distributed before the date.
